

Regulations for Fund Raising Activities along roads and highways within the City of Lawtey:

1. Only non-profit organizations or groups shall be permitted to solicit funds on roads and highways within the City of Lawtey.
2. All persons engaged in fund raising activities must wear a traffic safety vest at all times.
3. All persons under the age of eighteen (18) shall have the permission of their legal guardians to participate in the fund raising event and shall be under the supervision of an adult at all times.
4. No person under the age of twelve (12) shall be on any road or highway soliciting funds. All persons under the age of twelve must remain on the right of way and be under the direct supervision of an adult.
5. Only one individual at a time will be in any particular lane engaged in fund raising activities.
6. All persons engaging in fund raising activities shall abide by all safety instructions of any law enforcement officer during the event.
7. Participants will only enter the lanes of traffic when the light is red in the direction of which activities are conducted.
8. The Chief of Police or his designee may delay, cancel or stop any fund raising event on the roads or highways of the City of Lawtey at any time for public safety reasons, legal reasons, or when the event is determined to interfere with the safe flow of traffic or the peace and tranquility of the community.
